Dear Friends of the Mailing List:

Now that we are on the other side of Easter Sunday...

Between the overflow of letters, cards, Cubs' masks and an overabundance of Cheetos that have been flowing in, I guess we did really well on our Easter collection as well. Since the first week (when I put in \$1,000 to get the St. Pat's collection up to \$2,750), we have met our budgets at two of the three parishes I serve! Sacred Heart is in a downfall - we have less than \$300 in the bank and have bills coming in. I put in \$1,100 out of pocket to finish off the paying of our alarm bill. The monies that we expected for the flooring project at the Sacred Heart convent fell through (the parish in question could not do their Lenten fund drive for obvious reasons) but we are making ends meet. We have set up "Online Giving" sites for all three parishes (see below) and, to be honest (especially in relation to other parishes of the diocese), we are making our weekly budget goals. All of this is a testimony to your kindness at the parishes in our little Kankakee Bordertown communities. I feel blessed that I get to serve with all of you - we will do our part, you are doing your part and, by the time we get back together for community Masses, our parishes will be stronger for it.

Sr. Mary Beth Clements has been making constant "Sunshine Calls" to all the parishioners at Sacred Heart. Thanks to Mary Ann Dowding and Joanne Hermann at St. Patrick's as well as Cookie Schroeder and the CCW Ladies at St. Anne's, we have a list of over one hundred homebound folks who are being visited this way, just to make sure they are doing fine. If you know anyone else who needs to be on that list, please contact us!!!


SPANISH MASS FOR THE SECOND SUNDAY OF EASTER






